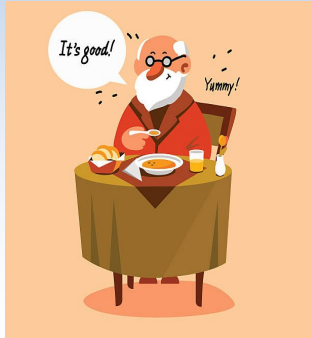

School supplies like pencils, crayons/markers, and notebooks, flip-flops, socks, collapsible water bottles, wash cloths, toothbrushes, hairbrushes, ball caps for boys, flashlights with extra batteries, sewing kits for girls, small cosmetic bags for girls (with items inside such as ponytail holders, emery boards, and jewelry), toys for older kids (can include jump ropes, yo-yos, small paddle ball sets, small stuffed animals), fishing kits* for boys

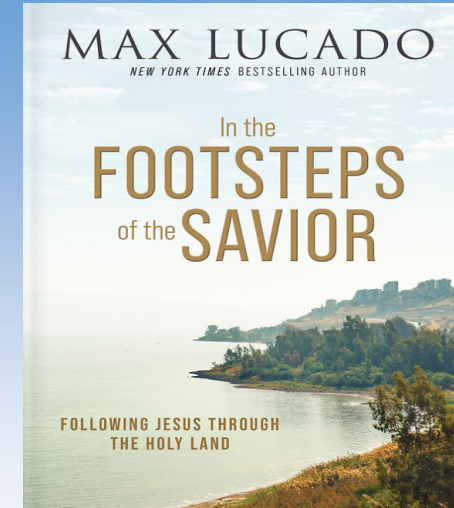


Mission Trip on Saturday, September 21

In 2023 NC Baptists on Mission coordinated delivering 21,142 backpacks to children and families in Appalachia. If you know anything about Appalachia, you know that it is filled with many areas of poverty. The goal this year is 22,000 backpacks. Clement's WOM has been a part of this ministry for several years. One of our sister churches, Lea Bethel, has gone "all-in" and last year actually went to a school in Kentucky and personally delivered the Gospel, backpacks and much more to a small community. On **Wednesday, September 4**, Sherry Stanfield-Oakley will be coming to share with our church family how to best fill our backpacks and how we can partner with them in their assignment to an Appalachian location this year. Mark your calendar now so that you don't miss hearing Sherry share how they saw God work in the children and families during their time there. May we enthusiastically join in this missions opportunity to show the love of Jesus to children that we will probably never meet ----- but they will know that someone, somewhere cared enough about them to send them a backpack filled with practical items, love and, most importantly, an age appropriate Bible meant to give them Jesus and hope.



This Fall on the first Wednesday night of each month, the ladies will be going through the Max Lucado study, "In the Footsteps of the Savior." Each of the video sessions will show some of the places where key events in the Gospels and Acts took place. We will share together in a group study time with each video. If you want to go deeper, there is a study guide which will lead you in personal study deeper into the Scriptures for each session. **We will begin this on October 2.** The Study Guide is about \$13 and can be ordered on Amazon.
